

Project Director of Belgian Kaschin-Beck Disease Control Foundation visit the Center for Endemic Disease Control

On November 7, Dr. F. Mathieu, Project Director of Belgian Kaschin-Beck Disease Control Foundation, Professor Camille Chasseur and Dr. He Lixin from the Institute for Endemic Disease Control of CDC in Tibet, visited the Center for Endemic Disease Control at HMU.

In the meeting, the leaders of the operation department gave a brief introduction to the center, its functions and the current condition of the endemic diseases in China. Professor Sun Dianjun, Vice Director of the center, on behalf of HMU and the center, extended a warm welcome to Dr. F. Mathieu and the other visitors.
